Criteria	Explanation	“√” or “-”
	1 check mark (√) per area	
Originality-	Only one in class with this design or something that no one else has thought of previously. Think of something no one else will.	
Elaboration: (must contain color)	Lots of details in picture, including a background that consists of more than a sun, clouds and grass. Appropriate coloring.	
Elaboration: (Title)	Title should be interesting and describe the picture.	
Complexity:	At least one item in the picture shows lots of detailing.	
Point of View: (Flexibility)	The transformation is not from the viewpoint of looking straight at it, but another angle is used such as an aerial view, etc.	
Resistance to Closure:	Something in the picture is not completely shown and/or runs off the page, leaving it to our imagination to complete the picture in our mind.	
Neatness	Creative effort is evident. Carefully executed work that reflects ALPHA standards and expectations.	
Punctuality	Transformation was completed on time and ready to submit at the beginning of class.
