- Classified as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit membership organization




TAGT Mission



HOUSE & Legislative Session

- Requires a policy regarding the use of funds to support the district's G/T program
- Requires districts to annually certify to TEA that the district has established a
 G/T program that is consistent with the state plan
- If the commissioner determines that a school district has failed to comply with the certification and state plan, the commissioner can reduce district's funding.
- Requires districts to report to TEA the use of funds on the district's G/T program
- Confirms that there is no limit to the number of students that a school district
 may identify as gifted and talented or serve under the district 's program for gifted
 and talented students.





The State Plan provides requirements for and guidance to districts as they meet the unique needs of the G/T population in Texas.

6.2 Input from family and community representatives on gifted/talented identification and assessment procedures is invited annually.



6.3 Information is shared or meetings are held annually requesting parent and community recommendations regarding students who may need gifted/talented services.

6.5 An array of learning opportunities is provided for gifted/talented students in grades K-12, and parents are informed of all gifted/talented services and opportunities.

6.6 Products and achievements of gifted/talented students are shared with the community.

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6.7 Orientation and periodic updates are provided for parents of students who are identified as gifted/talented and provided gifted/talented services.



6.8 The effectiveness of gifted/talented services is evaluated annually, shared with the board of trustees, and the data is used to modify and update district and campus improvement plans. Parents are included in the evaluation process, and the outcomes and findings of the evaluation are shared with parents.
